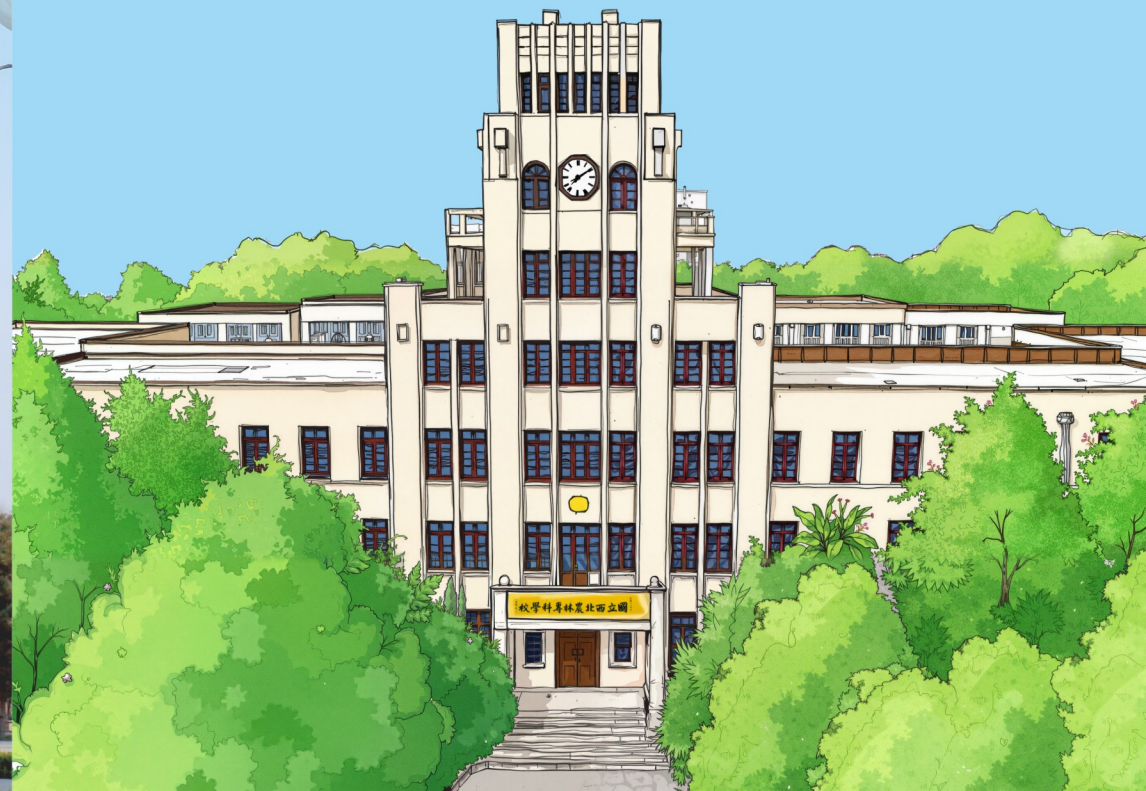

On July 4, 2024, Tashkent Campus NWAUFU was officially inaugurated. As the first Chinese university branch campus established in Uzbekistan, it is jointly built with Tashkent State Agrarian University. Northwest A&F University is an agricultural university with the most complete agricultural, forestry and aquatic disciplines in China, while Tashkent State Agrarian University is the most prominent agricultural university in Uzbekistan, distinguished by its overall strength and strong disciplinary influence.

## I. Program Overview

1. Program Level: Master's Degree

2. Majors Offered: Agronomy and Seed Industry (Agriculture), Agronomy and Seed Industry (Horticulture), Plant Protection, Animal Husbandry, Agricultural Management, Agricultural Engineering and Information Technology, Artificial Intelligence, Computer Technology, Biology and Medicine.

3. Start Date: September 2026

4. Program Duration: 2 years, adopting a "1+1" joint training model

5. Program Structure: Students will complete the first year of coursework at Tashkent State Agrarian University and undertake the second year of research at Northwest A&F University. Upon meeting the graduation requirements of both institutions, students will be awarded master's degrees from both universities.



## II. Fees and Charges

### 1. Tuition

The first year: 15,000,000 UZS (in accordance with relevant regulations in Uzbekistan, subject to the final announcement by Tashkent State Agrarian University)

The second year: 15,000,000 UZS (subject to the final announcement by Northwest A&F University).

### 2. Accommodation

First Year: Charged according to the regulations of Tashkent State Agrarian University, or students may choose to live off campus.

Second Year: Charged according to the regulations of Northwest A&F University (10,000,000 UZS), or students may choose to live off campus.





### III. Application Procedures

#### 1. Application Period

March 1, 2026 – June 30, 2026

#### 2. Eligibility

(1) Applicants must be in good physical and mental health and hold citizenship of Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan, or Tajikistan.

(2) Academic Requirement: Applicants must obtain a bachelor's degree by September 1, 2026.

(3) Language Requirement: Applicants must meet at least one of the following: TOEFL  $\geq$  80; IELTS  $\geq$  5.5; Duolingo English Test  $\geq$  95; or meet the English proficiency standards specified by the intended major.

#### 4. Interview Assessment

(1) Northwest A&F University and Tashkent State Agrarian University will jointly organize the interview. Applicants who are qualified will receive notification by email or phone regarding the assessment content, schedule, and other details. Candidates must participate on time as instructed.

(2) The Admissions Office will publish the assessment results on the official website and via email within two weeks after the interviews.

### IV. Application Documents

1. A copy of a valid foreign passport (photo page and signature page).

2. Scanned copies of the highest academic certificate and transcript, notarized by an authorized institution.

3. Study plan and research proposal for the master's program.

4. Two recommendation letters from experts holding the title of Associate Professor or above.

5. A copy of the PHYSICAL EXAMINATION RECORD FOR FOREIGNER (downloadable at: <http://sie.xjtu.edu.cn/en/2.pdf>).

6. Original Certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued within the past six months.

7. Northwest A&F University International Student Application Form.

8. Other supporting materials demonstrating academic competence (e.g., proof of language proficiency, published papers).

Note: \*Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be accompanied by a notarized Chinese or English translation.



## V. Scholarship

Based on the comprehensive evaluation results after one year of enrollment, outstanding self-funded students may receive one of the following two categories of scholarships:

**First-Class Scholarship:** Covers 50% of the tuition fees during the study period in China.

**Second-Class Scholarship:** Covers accommodation fees during the study period in China.

## VI. Supervision and Review Mechanism

1.The international student admission process of our university follows the principles of openness, fairness, and impartiality, with strict selection procedures and strengthened process management to ensure transparency of admission results.

2.Any applicant found to have engaged in falsification or fraudulent practices will have their admission qualification immediately revoked; if discovered after enrollment, the student will be expelled.

3.Other violations will be handled in accordance with the relevant regulations of the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China.



## VII. School Life

### Sports venue

Both the North and South campus have a variety of sports facilities, including basketball courts, table tennis tables, and badminton courts. Students can make reservations to use them.

### Library

The total amount of paper resources collected in the library amounts to 2.8506 million volumes (including 2.2305 million volumes of Chinese and foreign language books, 345,000 volumes of bound volumes of Chinese and foreign language periodicals, over 235,000 volumes of materials such as dissertations, and 40,100 volumes of other literature and materials). There are 107 domestic and foreign electronic resource libraries (including 71 foreign language databases and 36 Chinese databases). It mainly includes databases such as Elsevier Science electronic journals, Science Online electronic journals, Nature electronic journals, Spring-Link electronic journals, and China National Knowledge Infrastructure (CNKI); There are over 2,051,900 domestic and foreign electronic books, over 23,000 full-text electronic periodicals in Chinese and foreign languages, and over 10.1005 million electronic dissertations.

### Classroom

The university is equipped with smart classrooms, multimedia interactive classrooms, and other facilities to meet the interactive teaching needs of different courses.

### International student dormitory

The university has international student dormitories with double occupancy rooms. Each floor of the dormitories is equipped with a shared kitchen, which comes with a complete set of facilities including induction cookers, refrigerators, washing machines, and more.

### Convenient life

Both the North and South Campus are home to a number of canteens, which offer a wide variety of dishes including special sections such as halal food. Besides, the campuses boast a full range of shops selling diverse foods, medicines and daily necessities, enabling students to meet all their daily needs without stepping off campus.
